17 day of Oct 1861 as a Private Co. a Regt. 51 Ohio
and was finally discharged on the 23 day of January 1865 as Private Co. a
51 Regt. Ohio by reason of General orders
having served 4 years 3 months 6 months. Joined this Post by 18
