Wife of the Governor of the State of Missouri

Mrs. Warren E. Hearnnes is the former Miss Betty Cooper, daughter of Mrs. A. B. Cooper and the late Rev. A. B. Cooper. She was born July 24, 1927. Valedictorian of her Charleston, Missouri high school graduating class, she attended Southeast Missouri State College at Cape Girardeau before receiving her B.S. degree in public school music from the University of Missouri in June, 1952—the same day Governor Hearnnes added an A.B. degree to his B.S. degree from West Point and two months before he received an L.L.B. degree from the University of Missouri School of Law.

Music has been her principal hobby and she taught music in Charleston and Sikeston Schools. She was organist at the Baptist Church in Charleston, assistant organist and choir member at the First Baptist Church in Jefferson City, where she and Governor Hearnnes have attended since his election as Secretary of State in 1960, after serving ten years in Missouri's House of Representatives. She has also appeared in recitals and concerts and has been active in music clubs. Mrs. Hearnnes is the mother of three daughters: Lynn, Leigh and Julia B.

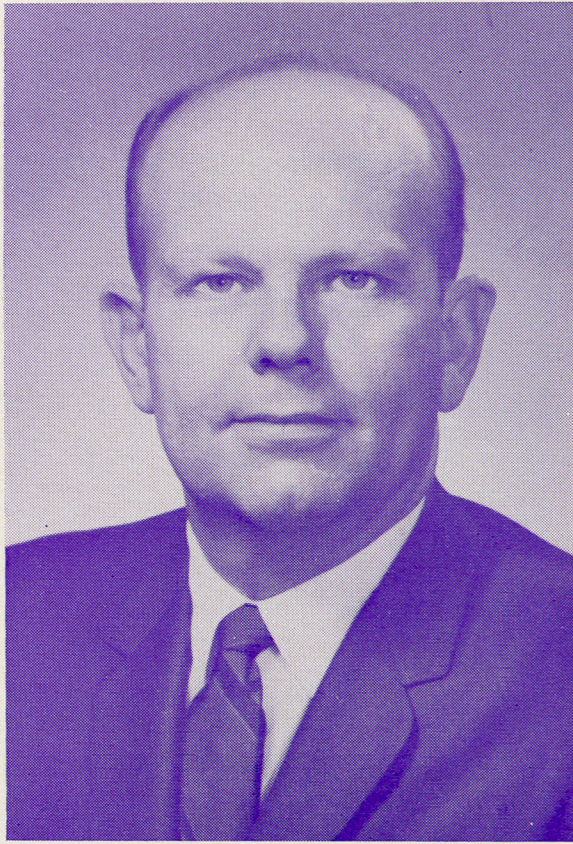

**SENATOR A. BASEY VANLANDINGHAM**  
State Senator of Missouri, District 19

A. Basey Vanlandingham (Democrat), Senator from the 19th District of Missouri, was born March 30, 1920, in Boone County, Missouri. He was educated in a rural school, the public schools of Columbia, Missouri, and the University of Missouri. He was married to Miss Lorane Glascock on December 31, 1939, in Boone County. They have two sons and a daughter—A. Basey II, Forrest Barry and Becky Lynn. He is a member of the Christian Church, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks, the Masonic Lodge, in which he is presently serving as Grand Master of the Grand Lodge, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Missouri. He is a member of Consistory No. 1, A.A.S.R. Valley of St. Louis, is an active member of the York Rite Masonry in Missouri, served as the Grand High Priest of the Grand Chapter, Royal Arch Masons of Missouri, 1962-63. He is also a member of the Ararat Temple, A.A.O.N.M.S. in Kansas City, Missouri, and president of the John W. "Blind" Boone Memorial Foundation, Incorporated. President of Missouri-Arkansas Basin Flood Control District No. 6, member of President Kennedy's Advisory Board of Natural Resources, 1960-61, member of Midwest Agriculture Committee, Council of State Governments. He has engaged in livestock and grain farming in Howard and Boone counties the past 25 years. He received the Balanced Farming Award for Boone County in 1956. He was elected to the House of Representatives in 1956, and reelected in 1958. He received the St. Louis Globe-Democrat award for Meritorious Public Service as the outstanding freshman representative in the 69th General Assembly. In the 70th General Assembly he served as speaker pro-tem. of the House of Representatives. He was elected to the Missouri State Senate in 1960, reelected in 1964. In the 73rd General Assembly he served as chairman of the committee on Agriculture, and as a member of the following committees: Appropriations, Banks and Banking and Financial Institutions; Correctional Institutions; Employment Security; and Public Health and Welfare.

He is Chairman of the Board of Exchange Bank, New Franklin, Missouri, and Chairman of the Board and President of Central Finance Company, Inc., Columbia, Missouri.

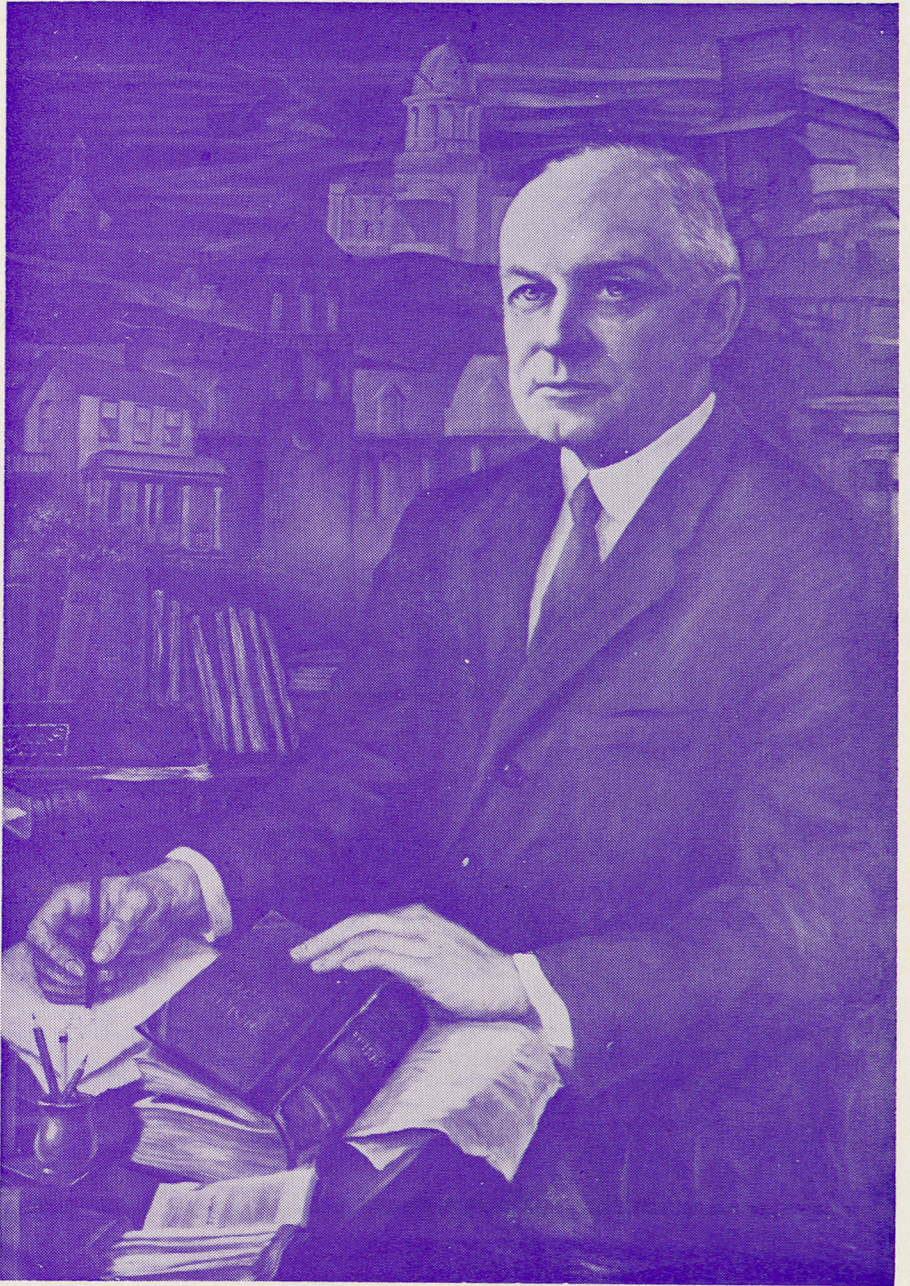
