**DR. SHAILA AERY**  
Commissioner of Higher Education

As a student, teacher and administrator, Dr. Shaila Aery has been involved in education all of her life. A native of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Aery received her bachelor's degree from the University of Oklahoma and taught history and government in the Oklahoma City Public School System until 1967.

While a member of the Oklahoma State University staff, Aery received her master's in curriculum and instruction and earned a doctorate in educational psychology. During her tenure at Oklahoma State, she was a faculty member and an administrator in student services and academic affairs. Aery also served on the staff of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the coordinating board for higher education in that state.

In 1978, Aery joined the administrative staff and faculty at the University of Missouri-Columbia as an assistant professor and special assistant to the chancellor. Two years later, Aery was appointed assistant provost for academic affairs at the university.

Aery joined the staff of Missouri's Coordinating Board for Higher Education as deputy commissioner in 1981. In October, 1982, she was appointed to her present position as the commissioner of higher education for the state.

The Coordinating Board for Higher Education is responsible for statewide planning, academic program review and approval, budget recommendations for state-supported colleges and universities and for the administration of the Missouri State Library, the Wolfner Memorial Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, the Missouri Guaranteed Student Loan Program, the Missouri Prospective Teachers Loan Program and the Missouri Student Grant Program.

It was under Aery's direction that the Coordinating Board devoted two years to studying the state's public colleges and universities. The study, "Strengthening the Investment in Missouri Public Higher Education," recommended several changes in the state's system to strengthen academic quality and end duplication among Missouri's institutions. House Bill 196, which designated Northeast Missouri State University as the statewide public liberal arts and sciences university, was one historical outgrowth of the Board's study.

In addition to her position as the chief executive officer to the Coordinating Board for Higher Education, Aery is a gubernatorial appointee to the Education Commission of the States. The ECS conducts research and public policy studies in education nationwide. Aery also serves as chairman of the Federal Relations Committee of the State Higher Education Executive Officers and is a member of this national organization's Executive Committee.

Aery, designated as one of the Outstanding Young Women of America in 1974, is currently listed in Who's Who of American Women and Who's Who in the Midwest. In 1985, she was selected as a Danforth Foundation Fellow to attend Harvard University's Executive Seminar in State and Local Government.

The dot next to the top button is a symbol of the degree earned the time when robes and hoods were the proper fashion for the everyday wear. Although the garments change in appearance from generation to generation, the color and the decoration of each the robe and hood signify the degree and specialization. These are the primary standards of comparison used across the world.

To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns and hoods that has been adapted by all institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book.

The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social status.

The doctoral hood did not become a symbol of the degree until the time when robes and hoods were no longer fashionable for everyday wear. Although the present costume is reserved for ceremonial use, the color, cut and decoration of both the robe and hood signify the degree and specialization. There are literally hundreds of variations used around the world.
