

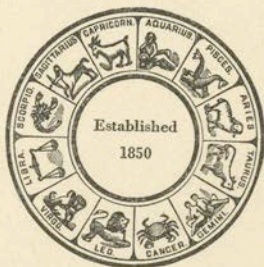

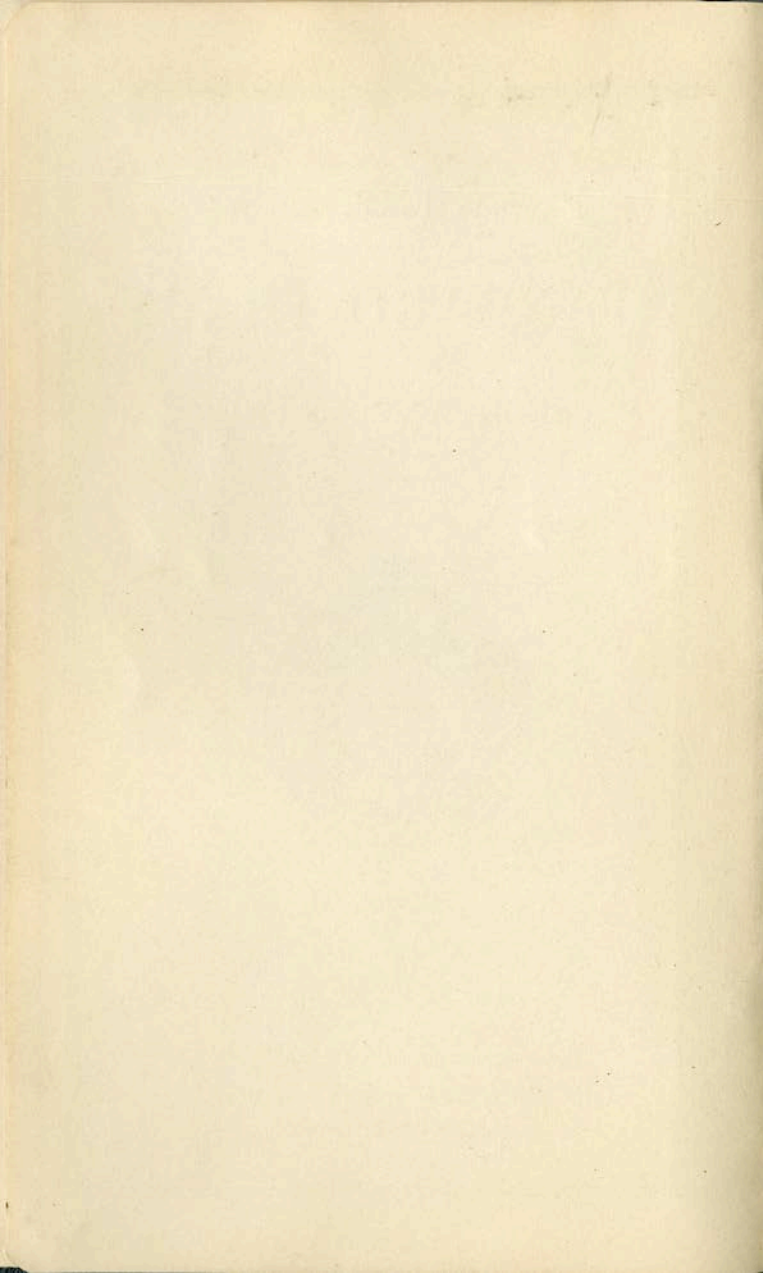

the 100 prize winning numbers.  
We were not lucky.

giving away \$5000 worth of  
goods. A neighbor drew a  
dining room set valued at \$50.

Uncle Ira rode out with  
us from town. He went to Johnsons.

JANUARY 6

19

Clear today. thayed some.  
We butchered 3 hogs today.

28

JANUARY 7

Mostly cloudy today  
and warm. Still some snow  
in drifts.

Russell worked for Zeiglers  
today.

We cleaned out the barn  
and rendered lard today.

I got a letter from Luella  
today. They have 3 feet of snow  
at Livingston Mont. and  
it was 40 degrees below zero on  
New Years eve.

Abbie Bragg phoned from  
our place this M.

The hog Cholera has broken  
out about Youngstown.

Russell and Mildred  
went to Harrys this A.M.

and has been cool today.


I hauled a load of
