S. E. GERARD PRIESTLEY

Dr. Priestley was born in the borough of Windsor, England; had his undergraduate education at New College, University of London, and has the Master's and Doctor's degrees from the Graduate School of Arts and Science, New York University. He holds the degrees of Bachelor of Divinity and Master of Sacred Theology from the Hartford Theological Seminary, and Master of Social Science in International Relations from the New School for Social Research, New York. He has done postgraduate work at the Universidad Nacional de Mexico and Union Theological Seminary, New York. He has taught European History at Springfield College and at New York University.

Dr. Priestley has written on the Agrarian Problem in Mexico, the Proposed Federation of the British West Indies, The Role of Agriculture in the Argentine, and Some Problems and Achievements of Pan-Americanism.

His travels have taken him to sixty countries on five continents in the past twenty years. Last year he completed a six-month, 40,000-mile trip around the world when he studied economic, social and political developments in New Zealand, Australia, Indonesia, Malaya, Thailand, India, Pakistan, Iraq, the Near East and Germany.

Dr. Priestley is president of the Council for International Education and Research, Inc., with headquarters in St. Charles, Missouri.
