I served during the late rebellion as follows:

First enlisted Nov 2nd 1861 as Capt in Co. D 1st Regiment Iowa Inf for the period of 3 years, and was discharged therefrom as at Washington city on the 19 day of November 1862 by reason of Disability

I also reenlisted 1st May 1864 as Capt in Co. C 115 Regiment Iowa Inf and was discharged therefrom as at Keokuk Iowa on the 16 day of September 1864 by reason of Expiration of Term of Service

I have never borne arms against the United States, and have never been convicted by Court-Martial of Desertion, nor of any other infamous crime.

I have ~~never~~ made previous application for membership to the Grand Army of the Republic and filed the same with Corporal Dix Post No. Department of Missouri on the 17 day of July 1864

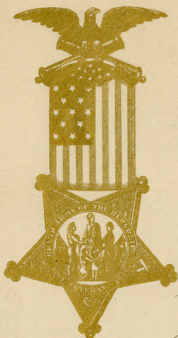
