Juanita Kreps

When the 39th president, Jimmy Carter, entered office in January 1977, he appointed Juanita Kreps the United States Secretary of Commerce. Not only was she the first woman to serve in this capacity, she was the first economist to hold the cabinet post. Mrs. Kreps is currently Vice President Emeritus and the James B. Duke Professor of Economics (on leave) at Duke University in Durham, North Carolina.

Mrs. Kreps holds a bachelor's from Berea College in Berea, Kentucky, a master's and doctorate from Duke, and honorary degrees from several colleges and universities. She was named the James B. Duke Professor of Economics in 1972 and University vice president in 1973. She held the position of Secretary of Commerce from January 1977 to December 1979.

Prior to her government post, Mrs. Kreps served on several boards of directors, including the New York Stock Exchange. Since leaving the Department of Commerce, she has rejoined or joined the boards of Allegis Corporation, Armco Incorporated, American Telephone and Telegraph Company, Chrysler Corporation, Citicorp/Citibank, Deere and Company, Eastman Kodak Company, J.C. Penney Company, RJR Nabisco Incorporated and Zurn Industries Incorporated. She is a trustee of the Duke endowment fund and TIAA Stock, and is a member of CREF.

Mrs. Kreps received the North Carolina Public Service Award in 1976, the American Association of University Women's Achievement Award in 1981, the North Carolina Citizens' Association's Public Service Award in 1982, and the first Duke University Distinguished Alumni Award in 1983. In 1987, Mrs. Kreps received the Industry Achievement Award from the National Association of Bank Women, the first Corporate Governance Award from the National Association of Corporate Directors, the Directors' Choice Leadership Award from the National Women's Economic Alliance Foundation, and the Duke University Alumni Medal for Distinguished Meritorious Service.

Currently a director of the Council on Foreign Relations, Mrs. Kreps was the 1983 vice president of the American Economic Association and served as president of the Southern Economic Association. She is a former chairman of the Commission on Academic Affairs of the American Council on Education and of the Board of Trustees of the Educational Testing Service. She is a former member of the Council of the American Association of University Professors, former president-elect of the American Association for Higher Education and former vice president of the Gerontological Society.

Mrs. Kreps and her husband, Dr. Clifton H. Kreps Jr., have three children, Sarah, Laura and Clifton III.

The Honorable Inks Franklin, president

Dr. Franklin of Rocheport, Missouri, is retired from the Missouri State Teachers Association. Until 1978, he served as president of KFAL radio in Fulton, Missouri, and KLEX radio in Lexington, Missouri. She is also a trial lawyer for the St. Charles County Juvenile Office. She is a graduate of Lindenwood College and the St. Louis University School of Law.

The Honorable Kimberly A. Ahrens

A 1968 graduate of Northeast Missouri State University, Mrs. Ahrens is a French teacher at Hannibal High School in Hannibal, Missouri. She performed graduate work at Eastern Connecticut State College and at Northeast Missouri State University. She was appointed to the Board in April 1987.

The Honorable Elmira Baiotto

Mrs. Baiotto is a 1966 master's graduate and a former nursing instructor at Northeast Missouri State University. A registered nurse, she is currently the coordinator of the practical nursing program at the Kirksville Area Vocational-Technical Center. She is also a graduate of Washington University in St. Louis. She has been a member of the Board since 1983.

The Honorable Frederick C. Lauer

A recently retired dentist, Dr. Lauer owns the Mid-America Denture Clinic in Mt. Vernon, Missouri. He is a 1950 graduate of Northeast Missouri State University and a 1956 graduate of the University of Missouri-Kansas City dental school. He now lives in Raytown, Missouri. He began his Board term in 1986.

The Honorable Richard S. Pryor

Mr. Pryor is president and chief executive officer of the Bank of Jacomo in Blue Springs, Missouri, and president of the Missouri Bankers Association. He is a graduate of Columbia College and attended the American Institute of Banking and the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin. He was appointed to the Board in 1986.

The Honorable Michelle A. Blotevogel, student representative

The Commencement Ceremony

The University

In 1867, Joseph Baldwin returned to Missouri from Indiana, looking for a location to open a school to educate teachers. On Sept. 2, 1867, Baldwin opened the North Missouri Normal School and Commercial College in Kirksville. In 1870, Baldwin's school became the First District Normal School of Missouri, the first in the state's new normal school system, dedicated to the education of teachers for the public schools.

At the close of the 1869-70 academic year, the Normal School graduated its first class of 15 men. The Commencement program was held in the auditorium of the Cumberland Academy building on Friday, June 24, 1870. President Joseph Baldwin preached the sermon and T.A. Parker, state superintendent of schools, delivered the address.

Today, Missouri's statewide public liberal arts and sciences university celebrates its 118th Spring Commencement with more than 1,000 men and women graduating with bachelor's, master's and specialist's degrees in 100 areas of study in the liberal arts and sciences. Although the people, the campus and the mission of Northeast Missouri State University have changed during the last 118 years, the traditions of the commencement ceremony have remained intact.

The Dress

The academic costume worn today is the dress of the medieval secular clergy with a few alterations introduced by 16th century Protestant reformers. The intellectual revival of the 12th century gave impetus to the founding of the European universities. Students in these institutions were clerks; thus, they wore the dress of the secular clergy. In the 16th century, Protestant reformers, who associated academic habits with popery, adopted more civilian gowns.

The oldest article of academic wear was the robe, which was a loose gown. The habit, a tunic with short, wide sleeves, was worn over the robe. A hood lined with fur or inexpensive skins could be gathered around the neck or pulled up on the head as a turban. Finally, there were three kinds of caps worn: the round cap, reserved for doctoral dignity; a round cap with strings tied under the chin, worn by jurists; and the square cap. Universities such as Oxford made the square cap official; however, secular universities adopted the Tudor bonnet still worn by doctors of law, medicine and music.

American academic costume was not established until 1895. It consists of three types of gowns, three styles of hoods and two kinds of cap tassels. The bachelor's gown has long, pointed open sleeves with no ornamentation. The master's gown has even longer sleeves, which are closed at the bottom but feature openings about halfway down for the hands. The doctor's gown has full-length lapels of velvet and bell-shaped sleeves with three horizontal velvet bars. The color of caps and gowns is usually black; however, some universities feature doctoral gowns of distinctive colors, such as Harvard's crimson and Yale's deep blue. Many schools outside the United States have also adopted colorful gowns.

The doctor's hood is the longest and fullest among the degrees. The major field of study can be determined from the velvet facing on the hood according to the following color scheme: white, the arts; gold-yellow, science; purple, law; apricot, nursing; green, medicine; sapphire, business administration; lemon, librarianship; scarlet, theology; dark blue, doctors of philosophy.

The hood is lined with silk in the colors of the institution which granted the degree. Northeast's master's graduates, for example, wear a purple and white-lined hood. The faculty at Northeast Missouri State University represent doctoral-granting institutions around the world. A few of their hood colors are the blue and white of Duke, the orange and black of Princeton, the crimson of Harvard, and the scarlet of Oxford.

The candidates for graduation wear black caps to which are attached tassels of colors illustrative of their degrees:

White: *Bachelor of Arts, Master of Arts, Master of Science*

Yellow-Gold: *Bachelor of Science*

Pink: *Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Music Education*

Apricot: *Bachelor of Science in Nursing*

Blue: *Bachelor of Science in Education, Specialist in Education*

The gold-tasseled cords worn by some of the undergraduate degree candidates signify the designation of "honor graduate." There are three levels of honor based on cumulative grade point average: cum laude, 3.50-3.75; magna cum laude, 3.75-3.89; summa cum laude, 3.89-4.00.

The academic procession is led by the faculty marshal. The marshal carries the University mace, which symbolizes the academic corporate body of scholars possessing its own jurisdiction and its own legally constituted authority. The mace is decorated with purple and white tassels and ribbons, and is topped with the University seal.

Following the marshal are the platform guests dressed in doctoral robes with hoods featuring the purple and white colors of the University. They are followed by the University faculty who wear the academic dress of their respective doctoral-granting institutions. The assistant faculty marshal leads the major portion of the procession, comprised of the degree candidates assembled according to the degree being granted.

Junior marshals appear throughout the procession dressed in white robes and caps. They are University students who help form the procession and seat the commencement participants.

The academic procession begins at Baldwin Hall and moves through the campus quadrangle. The procession halts in front of Kirk Memorial where the valedictorian of the graduating class lays a wreath at the foot of the statue of Joseph Baldwin, founder of the University. The procession marches down the east side of the quadrangle, turning east in front of Ophelia Parrish, then south on Florence Street to Patterson Street. It proceeds between Fair Apartments and Grim Hall, in front of Pershing Building and around the western portion of the track in Stokes Stadium.
