ANNA LEE WALDO

Anna Lee Waldo is a St. Louis housewife, mother of five, chemistry teacher and author of a book that has sold over a million copies.

Mrs. Waldo wrote the best-selling historical novel, "**Sacajawea.**" Her interest in the subject began as a child when she collected spear points on the shore of Whitefish Lake in Montana and listened to stories of the early Blackfeet and Crow Indians.

It took Mrs. Waldo 10 years to write the 1,342-page biography about the only woman on the Lewis and Clark Expedition. Four years later, in 1979, the book was printed by Avon publishers after extensive verification of her extremely detailed narrative.

At present she is writing another novel about the early American West while teaching at St. Louis Community College-Meramec. She has been with the science department there for eight years.

In high school Mrs. Waldo showed a talent for science and was awarded the Bausch and Lomb Science Award. She majored in chemistry at Montana State College-Bozeman. Upon graduation she was given the Richardson Award for women's excellence in science. She earned her Master's Degree in Organic Chemistry at the University of Maryland-College Park, where she did research under a U.S. Naval Scholarship.

At the University of Dayton in Ohio she taught organic chemistry and biochemistry. At Mercy Junior College she taught biochemistry for nursing students attending St. John's Mercy Hospital in St. Louis.

Mrs. Waldo wrote regularly for Chemical Abstracts Service, Columbus, Ohio, and published numerous technical papers, most of which were written while doing biochemical research at Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton.
