## THE FOLLOWING IS A CORRECT TRANSCRIPT FROM THE RECORDS OF THE POST:

Comrade *Samuel Frankford* is *46* years of age, was born in *Fredricksville* State of *Illinois* and is by occupation a *Fisherman* entered the service on the *21* day of *October* *1861* as a *Private* Co. *A* *18<sup>th</sup>* Regt. *Mo. Infantry* and was finally discharged on the *18* day of *July* *1865* as *2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut* Co. *A* *18* Regt. *Mo. Inf.* by reason of *Close of War* having served *3* years *9* months. Joined this Post by *Mustering in Sep 19* *1885*
