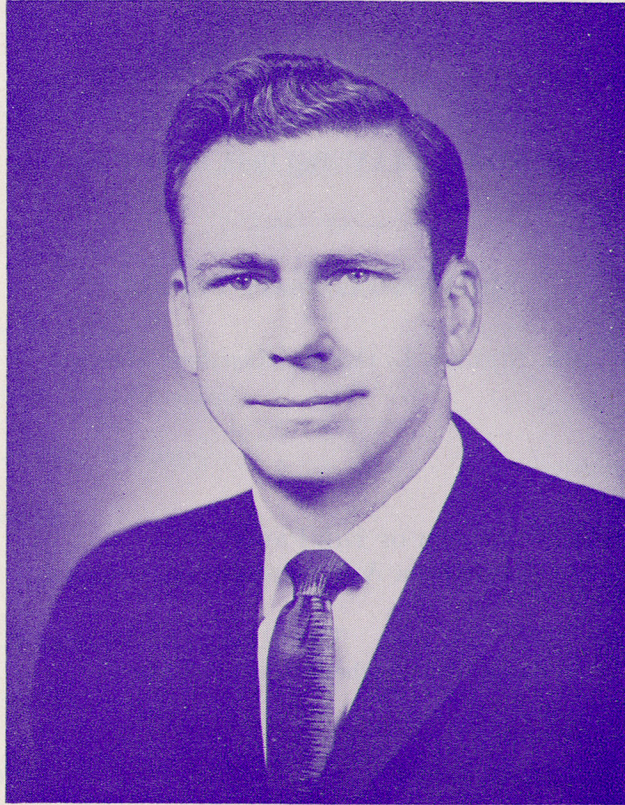

WARREN E. HEARNES  
Governor of the State of Missouri

Governor Warren E. Hearnes, forty-sixth governor of the State of Missouri, was born in Charleston, Missouri, July 24, 1923. He was educated in the Charleston public schools and served in World War II as an enlisted man in Headquarters Company, 140th Infantry, 35th Division, 77th Anti-Aircraft, AWSP. He was graduated from the United States Military Academy, West Point, New York, in 1946 with a B.S. degree and he was commissioned a second lieutenant in the regular army, June 4, 1946. He was advanced to the rank of first lieutenant December 12, 1947 and was retired December 31, 1949.

Governor Hearnes was graduated from the University of Missouri in 1952 with the A.B. and L.L.B. degrees and practiced law in East Prairie from 1952 to 1961. He was elected to the House of Representatives of the Missouri General Assembly from Mississippi County in 1950, the youngest man ever elected state representative from that county. He was re-elected in 1952, 1954, 1956, and 1958. In 1957 he was chosen majority floor leader and re-elected in 1959.

On January 9, 1961, Warren E. Hearnes became the 30th Secretary of State of Missouri, and on November 4, 1964, he was elected Governor of Missouri, by a record vote of 1,110,651 and a plurality of 431,702.

In 1948 Governor Hearnes was married to the former Betty Sue Cooper and they have three daughters, Lynn, Leigh, and Julia B. Governor Hearnes is a member of the First Baptist Church of Jefferson City; the Masonic Lodge; Scottish Rite and the Shrine; Lions Club; Order of Elks; Order of Eagles; American Legion; Veterans of Foreign Wars; and Phi Delta Phi and Phi Delta Theta, legal fraternities.

Representative, Ninth District of Missouri

William L. (Bill) Hungate, Representative, Ninth District of Missouri, is forty-two, a native of Pike County, Missouri, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. L. W. Hungate, graduate of the University of Missouri and Harvard Law School. Admitted to Missouri, Illinois and Federal Bars. Since 1948 has practiced law in Troy, Missouri, and is presently a partner in the firm of Hungate and Grewach. Served three terms as Prosecuting Attorney of Lincoln County, Missouri, and served as Special Assistant Attorney General from 1958 to 1964. In 1956 he was employed by the American Bar Foundation and worked on the research project, "Survey of Criminal Justice," conducted in Wisconsin, Kansas and Michigan.

He is married to the former Dorothy N. Wilson of Cyrene, Missouri. They have two children—a son David, sixteen, and a daughter Kay, thirteen. He is veteran of World War II having served in the European Theatre in the 95th Infantry Division. He is Chairman of the Board of the First Christian Church of Troy, Past Lieutenant-Governor of Kiwanis, Past President Harvard Law School Association of Missouri, Member of American Legion, and Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Mr. Hungate is a member of the House Judiciary Committee, serving on the Subcommittee on Claims.
