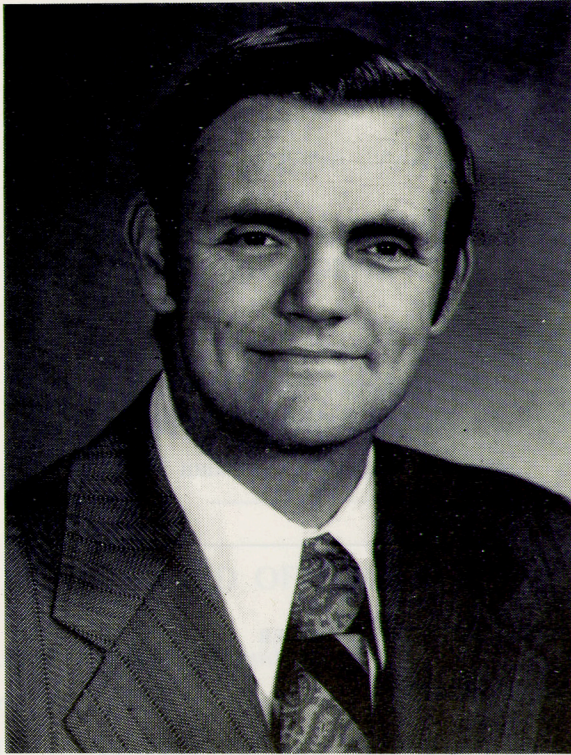

Dr. Bill W. Stacy is one of the rising stars in higher education in the Midwest. Just this year named president of Southeast Missouri State University at Cape Girardeau, the 42-year-old Virginia native has thus reached a pinnacle of his career at Southeast.

Today is not his first visit to Stokes Stadium. In the late 1950s he was an all-Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association football player for the Southeast Indians who regularly battled the NMSU Bulldogs for conference championships.

After receiving his bachelor's degree in 1960, Dr. Stacy taught for four years at Malden High School in Malden, Missouri.

From Malden he went to Southern Illinois University where he received his master's and doctor's degrees.

In 1968 he returned to his alma mater to teach in speech communication. He rose quickly through the academic ranks and in 1976 was named graduate dean.

Last year Dr. Stacy was named interim president and after a nationwide search was selected as president of the 108-year-old institution.

NMSU President Charles McClain, the "dean" of Missouri's public college presidents, has characterized Bill Stacy as a person "indefatigable in his support of low tuition in Missouri's public colleges and a person who already in his short tenure is moving Southeast Missouri State University forward in the 1980s."
