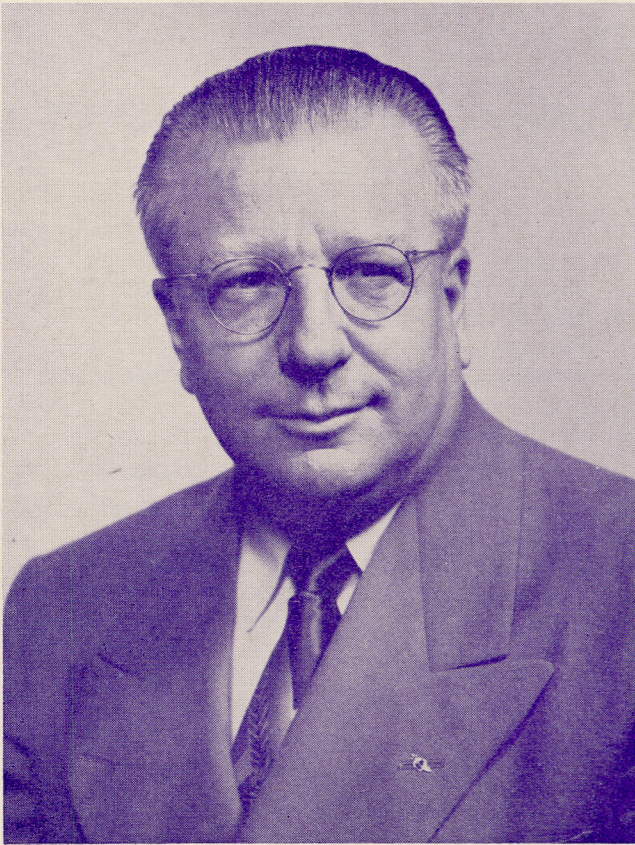

CLIFTON C. CORNWELL

Clifton Cornwell, now director of information in the Kirksville College of Osteopathy and Surgery, is an appropriate speaker on the occasion of the graduation of the May Division of the 90th Anniversary class, because for nearly forty years he has had association of one kind or another with this College. Cornwell received his bachelor of science in education degree here in 1925 and became a member of the faculty that year in the department of speech. Later he combined this work with the post of director of alumni activities and publicity. He left this College in 1945 to move across to K.C.O.S. where he has served as director of information, editor of the *Journal of Osteopathy*, and editor of the *Stillette*.

As a student and teacher of this State Teachers College, he was a member of Pi Kappa Delta, Phi Delta Kappa, Kappa Delta Pi, Phi Sigma Pi, Alpha Phi Sigma, and Phi Sigma Epsilon.

Cornwell has done a great deal of writing and public speaking. He has done graduate work at the State University of Iowa and at the University of Missouri. From the latter he holds the master of arts degree.

Cornwell married Villa Branson of Denslow, where he taught a rural school, and they have four children. Three of the four have received diplomas from Kirksville; the fourth one, Marilyn, is in the class that will come forward at the end of Mr. Cornwell's address, to receive diplomas.
