DR. RALPH W. SOCKMAN

Minister Emeritus, Christ Church, Methodist, New York City

Dr. Ralph W. Sockman was born in Mount Vernon, Ohio, and graduated from Ohio Wesleyan University. He continued his studies at Columbia University and Union Theological Seminary, receiving both his M.A. and Ph.D. from Columbia in New York. While there, Dr. Sockman was a layman at the Madison Avenue Methodist Church (now Christ Church, Methodist) and there received the inspiration that turned him toward the ministry. Having completed his seminary training at Union in 1916, he joined the Madison Avenue staff as Associate Minister. In 1917, he came into full pastorate of the church, where he has the unique record of having served over 44 years in his first and only parish. He retired and was named Minister Emeritus, December 31, 1961.

For 20 years Dr. Sockman served as president of the Council of Religion and International Affairs, formerly the Church Peace Union. He is chairman of the Men's Committee for the Japan International University in Tokyo. For 12 years he was Associate Professor of Practical Theology in Union Seminary. He is a trustee of Ohio Wesleyan University, Syracuse University, Drew University and New York University.

Dr. Sockman was named one of the six foremost clergymen of all denominations in this country today. He served also as president of the Protestant Council of the City of New York and at Duke University in 1954, he was hailed as "Dean of the American Protestant Pulpit." In addition to these activities, Dr. Sockman is the author of many books.

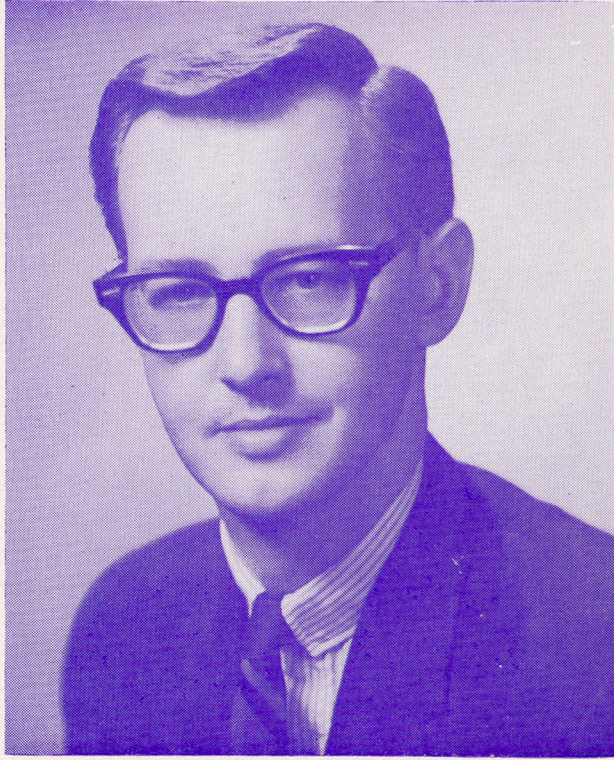

THE HONORABLE RICHARD SOUTHERN
State Senator from the 18th District of Missouri

Richard Southern of Monroe City, Monroe County, Missouri, was born in Madison, Missouri. He is a graduate of Madison Public School, Moberly Junior College, and the University of Missouri, where he received the B.A. Degree in 1958 and the L.L.B. degree in 1960. He married Nancy Youngs of Duncan's Bridge and they have three children, Rick, Deborah and Todd.

Mr. Southern is State Senator of the 18th Senatorial District, elected in 1966 at the age of 30. He served three terms as State Representative for Monroe County in the Missouri General Assembly; having been first elected at the age of 24, thus being the youngest Representative elected since 1935 and the fourth youngest since 1900. He served as Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee in his second term and in the 73rd General Assembly he served as Chairman of the House Committee on Civil and Criminal Procedure. He is presently a member of the following Senate committees: Appropriations, Agriculture, Conservation, Forestry, Parks and Natural Resources, Correctional Institutions and State Departments.

Mr. Southern is a member, deacon, Sunday School teacher, and Vice-Chairman of the Board of the First Christian Church of Monroe City. He is also an active member of the Masonic Lodge, York Rite Masons, Shrine, Eastern Star, Lions Club, Jaycees, Young Democrats and Business Men's Association, and served as Secretary-Treasurer of the 17th District Masonic Association. He was a charter member of the Monroe County Young Democrats, past chairman of the 9th District Young Democrats and State Parliamentarian. He was selected as an "Outstanding Young Man of America" by the Junior Chamber of Commerce.

GOVERNOR WARREN E. HEARNES

Governor Warren E. Hearnes was born July 24, 1923, the youngest of five children of Mrs. Edna May Eastman Hearnes and the late Earle B. Hearnes of Charleston.

He was educated in Charleston public schools and was graduated from the United States Military Academy, West Point, N. Y., in 1946 with a B.S. degree and from the University of Missouri, Columbia, in 1952 with A.B. and L.L.B. degrees.

Governor Hearnes began the practice of law in East Prairie in 1952, continuing through 1961. He was elected to the House of Representatives from Mississippi County in 1950, the youngest man at the time ever elected state representative from that county. Re-elected in 1952, 1954, 1956 and 1958, he was elected majority floor leader in 1957 and 1959.

He became the 30th Secretary of State of Missouri January 9, 1961 and was elected the 46th Governor of Missouri November 3, 1964.

During World War II, he was an enlisted man in Headquarters Company, 140th Infantry, 35th Division, 77th Anti-Aircraft, AWSP. He was commissioned a second Lieutenant in the infantry of the regular army June 4, 1946, and advanced to first lieutenant December 12, 1947. He was retired December 31, 1949. Following his retirement, he was elected to the state Legislature.

Governor Hearnes was married in 1948 to Miss Betty Sue Cooper of Charleston. They have three daughters, Lynn, Leigh and Julia B.

He is a member of the First Baptist Church of Jefferson City; the Masonic Lodge; Scottish Rite and the Shrine; Missouri Bar Association; Phi Delta Theta social and Phi Delta Phi Legal fraternities; Lions Club; Order of Elks; Order of Eagles; American Legion; and Veterans of Foreign Wars.
