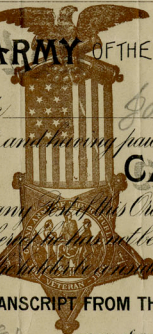

THE FOLLOWING IS A CORRECT TRANSCRIPT FROM THE RECORDS OF THE POST.

Comrade *James M. Shearer* is *80* years of age was born in *Marion Co*  
State of *Indiana* and is by occupation a *farmer* entered the service on the  
*6<sup>th</sup>* day of *March* 1862 as a *private* Co. *H* Regt. *13 Mo Cav*  
and was finally discharged on the *11<sup>th</sup>* day of *January* 1866 as *private* Co. *H*  
*13<sup>th</sup>* Regt. *Mo Cav* by reason of *Telegraphic instructions by Major <sup>Post</sup> ~~General~~*  
having served *three* years *5* months. Joined this Post by *application* 1892

*Rem. 1873*  
Dated at *Novelty* this *2<sup>nd</sup>* day of *June* 19*24*
