DR. HERBERT W. SCHOOLING
DEAN OF THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION
UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI

Dr. Herbert W. Schooling, a native Missourian, has been Dean of the Faculty of the College of Education of the University of Missouri Since September 1, 1963.

Dr. Schooling was born near Pierce City, Lawrence County, Missouri, in 1912. He was graduated from Southwest Missouri State College at Springfield with a B.S. in Education degree in 1936. He received two degrees from the University of Missouri, a Master of Arts (in secondary school administration) in 1940, and a Doctor of Education in 1954.

Dr. Schooling taught in the elementary and high schools in Cardwell and Pierce City, Missouri. He served as principal in Cardwell from 1939-40, and as superintendent of schools from 1940-41. He then went to Hayti, Missouri, as superintendent of schools, remaining there until 1944, when he was appointed principal of North Kansas City High School. He was named superintendent of schools of North Kansas City in 1950.

Dr. Schooling left North Kansas City in 1955 to become associate professor of education and director of pre-collegiate education at the University of Chicago. He also taught graduate courses in School Administration in the Summer Session for three years at the University of Missouri. In 1957, he became superintendent of schools at Webster Groves, Missouri, and retained that position until he was appointed Dean of the College of Education at the University of Missouri.

Dr. Schooling has been active in civic affairs as well as in professional education organizations. He has served as president of the Missouri Association of Secondary School Principals; president of the Missouri Association of School Administrators; chairman of the State Commission on Teacher Education and Professional Standards; member of the executive committee of the North Central Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges; regional director of the Association of Public School Systems, a national organization conducting research on educational systems; chairman of the Commission on Research and Service of the North Central Association; and member of the Executive Committee of the National School Public Relations Association.
