First enlisted *June 19* 18*61*, as *Private* in Co. *D* *13th* Regiment *Infantry, Vol.* for the period of *Three* years, and was discharged therefrom as *Private*, at *Golly Island Mo* on the *14th* day of *Dec* 18*63*, by reason of *Reenlistment As A Veteran*

¹ I also re-enlisted *Dec 14* 18*63*, as *Private* in Co. *D* *13th* Regiment *Infantry* and was discharged therefrom as *Lieut* at *Goldsboro N.C.* on the *17th* day of *Sept*, 18*65*, by reason of *Close of War*

I have never borne arms against the United States, and have never been convicted by Court-Martial of Desertion, nor of any other infamous crime.


