FOOD SERVICE HOURS for the summer are 6:30-8:30 a.m. weekdays and 8-9 a.m. Saturdays and Sundays for breakfast, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. daily for lunch, and 4:30-6 p.m. Monday through Saturday for dinner. No meals will be served on Sunday evenings.

RECREATIONAL SWIMMING HOURS for the summer are 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. weekdays and 10 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. Saturdays beginning Tuesday and lasting through Aug. 12. University students, faculty, staff and their families are admitted with a University ID.

Town and Gown swim will be in effect on those dates and hours on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays for a \$15 individual or \$25 family fee. Summer fees should be paid at the Business Office, 105 Administration/Humanities Building, and receipts should be brought to the Natatorium office. The pool will be closed during all legal University holidays and when classes are not officially in session.
