25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1864 as a Private Co. F Regt. 12<sup>th</sup> Mo. Cav.  
and was finally discharged on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 1866 as Private Co. F  
Regt. 12<sup>th</sup> Mo. Cav. by reason of Sick to Order O. 33  
having served 2 years 2 months. Joined this Post by August 15<sup>th</sup> 1882
