THE HONORABLE HAROLD HOWE II
United States Commissioner of Education

Harold Howe II, 48, was appointed by President Johnson as the 17th United States Commissioner of Education on December 18, 1965.

For two years prior to this appointment, Howe was executive director of the Learning Institute of North Carolina.

He received his A.B. degree from Yale in 1940, and an M.A. in History from Columbia in 1947. He has studied education at the University of Cincinnati and at Harvard.

He has served in a number of teaching and administrative positions in private and public schools, beginning in 1940 as a history teacher at Darrow School in New Lebanon, New York.

After five years in the U.S. Navy during World War II, Howe taught history at Phillips Academy in Andover, Mass. In 1950, he became principal of the Andover High School and Junior High School, and later served as principal of Walnut Hills High School in Cincinnati and of Newton (Mass.) High School. He was superintendent of Schools in Scarsdale, New York, from 1960 to 1964, when he became director of the Learning Institute of North Carolina.

Howe was a trustee of Vassar and Yale, a member of several professional education Societies, and was vice chairman of the College Entrance Examination Board until his present appointment. He has served as chairman of the Mayor's Committee on Juvenile Delinquency in Cincinnati, and as a member of the Commission of the Humanities of the American Council of Learned Societies.

He is married to the former Priscilla Foster Lamb of New York City. They have a married daughter, another daughter at Wellsley, and a teenage son.
