airport. He is in Las Vegas.

I sent the payment of the AARP ~~Life~~
Health Insurance today. I paid for
Jan. Feb. and March of 1992 595.50

Jan 21 1992 Clear and warmer. It
has rained a lot since we got to
Arizona. It has been wetter and cooler
than any winter we have been here.
Harold left last Thursday. He was on
his way to Uruguay? South America.
He plans to be gone two weeks. He is
still working for the Co. that owns the
Gold mine in California. Merle and I
went with Harold and Mark + Tina
to Gene's place at Salt Lake City. We
drove to Las Vegas Christmas afternoon.
We stayed all night there and then drove
to Salt Lake City the next day.

Harold and Gene and all the kids went skiing the next day. The next day they rested. The next day, Sunday, Harold, ~~the~~ Mark and ~~Christina~~ Kristen went skiing.
