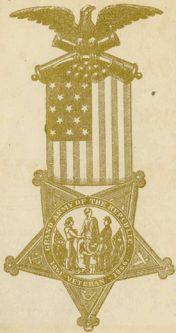

having served *2* years *10* months. Joined this Post by *Mustering in Jan 17th 1884*
