Comrade *James B. Hackett* is *42* years of age, was born in *Ortney*
State of *Vermont* and is by occupation a *Farmer* entered the service on the
21 day of *June* 1861 as a *Priv* Co *Ch. 11* Regt. *27* Vol *Inf*
and was finally discharged on the *20* day of *June* 1865 as *Priv* Co *6*
11 Regt. *27* *Inf* by reason of *Disability*
having served *3* years *—* months. Joined this Post by *Transfer* *188*
