Comrade *Christopher G. Pather* is *57* years of age, was born in *Bourbon County* State of *Kentucky* and is by occupation a *Carpenter* entered the service on the *7* day of *Nov* *1864* as a *Private* Co. *A* *39* Regt *Mo* *Inf* and was finally discharged on the *19* day of *July* *1865* as *Sgt* Co. *A* *39* Regt. *Mo* *Inf* by reason of *Genl Order No 181* having served *—* years *8* months. Joined this Post by *Musters on 2/1/88* *188*
