9th day of *Aug.* 1862 as a *Private* Co. *H* Regt. *134* *N.Y.*
and was finally discharged on the *22* day of *June* 1865 as *Private* Co. *H*
134 Regt. *N.Y. Inf.* by reason of *General Order No. 77*
having served *2* years *9* months. Joined this Post by *Card Jan 15 1905*
