WALTER C. PLOESER
GRAND ORATOR, GRAND LODGE A.F. & A.M. OF MISSOURI

Walter C. Ploeser of Manchester, Missouri is chairman of the Board, Ploeser, Watts and Co., Insurance which he organized in 1933. He is a graduate of Cleveland High School, St. Louis, Missouri and studied law at City College of Law and Finance and engaged in special studies in economics at Washington University. He received an Honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Norwich University, 1948 and Honorary Doctor of the Honoris Causa, National University of Asuncion, Paraguay, 1959. He married Dorothy Annette Mohrig and they have two married daughters.

Mr. Ploeser was a member of the Missouri legislature 1931-1932. He served four terms in Congress 1941-1949 and was Republican National Committeeman for Missouri 1964-1966. While in Congress he was a member of the Republican Steering Committee, Chairman (80th) Select Committee on Small Business; Chairman, Appropriations Sub-Committee on Government Corporation and was rated one of the top six orators of Congress in the 1940's. In 1934 and 1935 Mr. Ploeser founded the Young Republican Federation of Missouri and served as its first president. In 1937 and 1938 he served as Regional Chairman of the Republican National Program Committee.

During 1957-1959 Mr. Ploeser was ambassador to Paraguay where his principal mission was to stabilize the Republic's economy. He is considered as the "Father of Banco Fomento, Paraguay". The currency of Paraguay is considered the most stable in Latin America.

Mr. Ploeser is a 33° Scottish Rite Mason and is at present Sovereign Grand Inspector General in Missouri—Scottish Rite. He is active in DeMolay and served as Past Grand Master International Order of DeMolay-1952. He is active in the Royal Arch Masons, the Knights Templar and Shrine. He is now serving as Chairman, Board of Trustees, Scottish Rite Residence Foundation of St. Louis.

STUART SYMINGTON
UNITED STATES SENATOR FROM MISSOURI

A native of Massachusetts, Senator Symington was the son of a professor of languages at Amherst. Following service in World War I, he earned the A.B. degree at Yale. After graduation he worked with various electrical and iron and steel companies becoming president of Emerson Electric Manufacturing Company of St. Louis in 1938.

During World War II he served as a consultant to the War Department and in 1945 he became chairman of the Surplus Property Board. In 1947 Mr. Symington became the first Secretary of the Air Force. In 1951 he became administrator, Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

On November 4, 1952 Mr. Symington was elected United States Senator for Missouri and was reelected in 1959 and 1964. Senator Symington is a member of the Senate Aeronautical and Space Sciences, the Armed Services, and the Foreign Relations Committees; is an ex officio, voting member of the Senate Appropriations Committee, on Armed Services and Space Appropriations, and is a member of the Joint Economic Committee. He is Chairman of the Senate Subcommittee on National Stockpile and Naval Petroleum Reserves, a member of the Preparedness Investigating Subcommittee, and is a member of the Central Intelligence Subcommittee, all of the Armed Services Committee. He is Chairman of the Near Eastern and South Asian Affairs, a member of the European Affairs Subcommittee, and Disarmament Subcommittee, all of the Foreign Relations Committee. He is a member of the Democratic Steering Committee and the Democratic Policy Committee.

He holds many honorary degrees, including the following from Missouri: 1953, Doctor of Laws, William Jewell College, Liberty; 1957, Doctor of Laws, Park College, Parkville; 1958, Doctor of Letters, College of Osteopathy and Surgery, Kirksville; 1959, Doctor of Laws, Rockhurst College, Kansas City; 1963, Doctor of Laws, Avila College, Kansas City; 1963, Doctor of Humane Letters, Missouri Valley College, Marshall; 1965, Doctor of Laws, University of Missouri, Columbia; and 1966, Doctor of Laws, Washington University, St. Louis.

Senator Symington is married to Evelyn Wadsworth, daughter of former United States Senator James W. Wadsworth of New York. They have two sons, Stuart and James, both veterans and Missouri lawyers, and six grandchildren.
