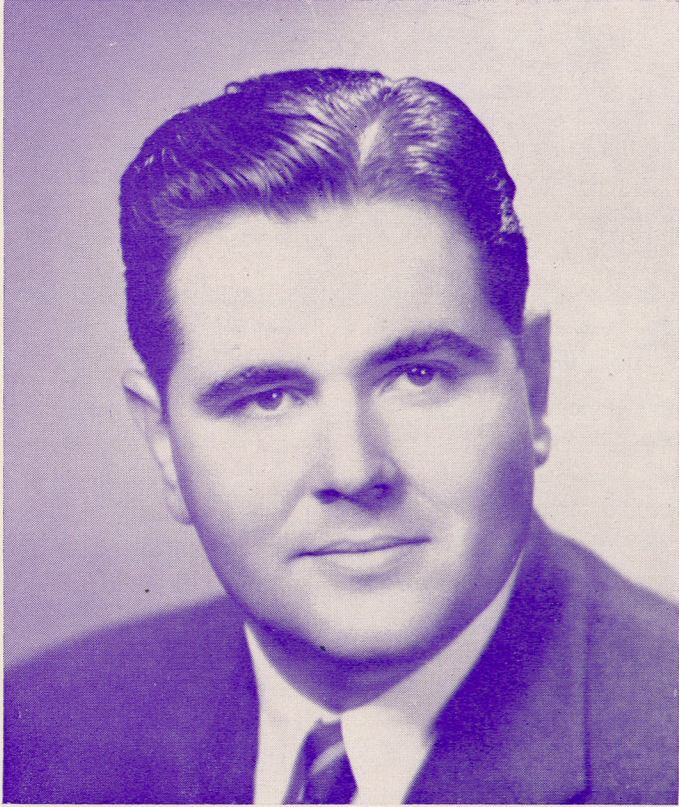

GEORGE D. YOUNG, Ph.D.

Dr. George D. Young was born at Rocheport, Boone County, June 16, 1930. He was graduated from Fayette High School in 1947, the University of Missouri with a bachelor of science degree in 1950, Cornell University in New York with a master's degree in public administration in 1951, and the University of Missouri with a doctor of philosophy degree in 1958. Dr. Young's major was in political science. He served in the United States Air Force from 1952 to 1954 and was discharged a first lieutenant. He was married in 1956 to Miss Ann Krochman in Dallas, Texas. They have a daughter, Melissa Ann, born May 15, 1958. Dr. Young was elected to the Missouri House of Representatives from Howard County in 1954 and was re-elected in 1956 and 1958. In the Seventieth General Assembly he served as chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, and was a member of the Appropriations, Legislative Research, and Public Schools Committees. He is now engaged in the Investment Department of Transit Casualty Company, 901 Washington Avenue, St. Louis. His home is at 2812 Moniteau Drive.
