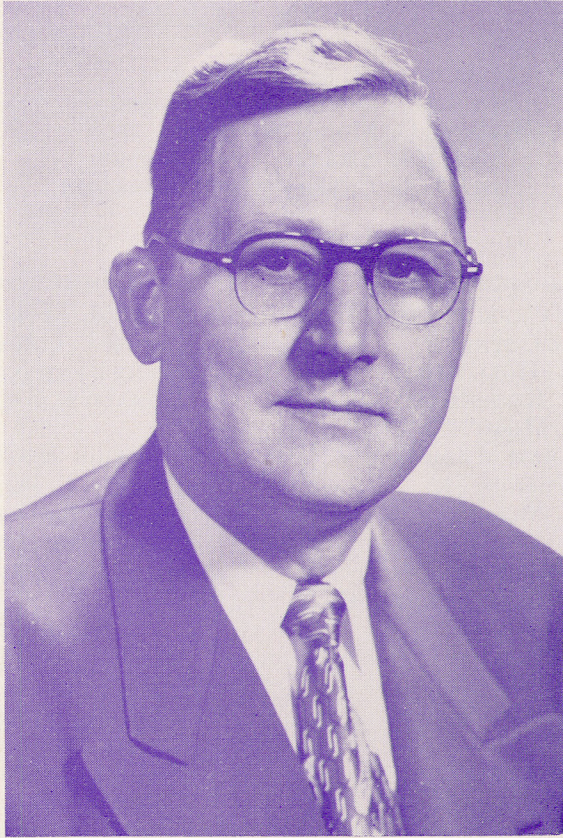

## FRED SCHWENGEL



Fred Schwengel, Congressman from the First District of Iowa during the past four years led all Iowans in his reelection campaign in 1958. Fred was born in Iowa and graduated from Sheffield, Iowa, High School, in 1926. He came to Northeast Missouri State Teachers College where he made a reputation as a football player and in various student enterprises. He was one of the founders of Phi Sigma Epsilon on this campus.

In 1931 Schwengel married Ethel Cassity of Purdin, Missouri, whom he met at Kirksville where both of them graduated. They have two children.

Schwengel taught in Shelbina and Kirksville High School from 1930 to 1937. He moved to Davenport, Iowa, in 1937. In 1944 he was elected to the Iowa legislature and served five terms.

He is recognized as a student of Lincoln and an authority on history of the Civil War period. He is now serving as president of the Lincoln Group of Washington, D. C. He is one of four members of the Civil War Centennial Commission appointed from the House of Representatives.
