JOHN BURLEIGH ARNOLD, L.L.B.

John Burleigh Arnold was born in 1931 in Lewistown, Missouri. He attended the public schools of Lewistown and graduated from high school in the spring of 1949. He entered Northeast Missouri State Teachers College and graduated in Business Administration and Speech, receiving a B.S. degree in Education with the Class of 1952. He entered the University of Missouri and earned his degree in Law (L.L.B.) in 1955.

After graduation from Law School, he served in the United States Army and was on the Army's Legal Staff in Washington, D. C., and is presently a 1st Lieutenant in the U.S.A.R.

In 1957, he was appointed by Governor James T. Blair, Jr. as Probate and Magistrate Judge in Schuyler County and was also an Instructor at Northeast Missouri State Teachers College at that time.

In May, 1958, he resigned his position as Probate and Magistrate Judge to accept an appointment as a State Assistant Attorney General. He served in this capacity until he was selected by Governor John M. Dalton to be his Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Arnold is a member of the Baptist Church, Masonic Lodge, Kiwanis Club, Who's Who in American Universities and Colleges, and Sigma Tau Gamma social fraternity.

He is married to the former Mary Brookhart and they have two sons.

HOMER L. KNIGHT, Ph.D.

Dr. Homer L. Knight, Professor and Head of the Department of History at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma, is a 1933 graduate of the Northeast Missouri State Teachers College. He holds the Master of Arts degree from the University of Texas, and the Ph.D. degree from the University of Missouri. He has done additional graduate work at the University of Hawaii.

His professional experience includes twelve years of teaching in the public schools of this area before joining the University of Missouri faculty for several years. Dr. Knight served as Associate Professor of History at the Northeast Missouri State Teachers College from 1945 through 1947, when he was named Professor and Head of the History Department of Westminster College. In 1948 he was named Dean of Men at Westminster, and in 1950, was named Dean of the College at that institution. He has served in his present position since 1954.

Dr. Knight delivered the First Annual Joseph Baldwin Lecture on the Teachers College campus in 1957. He is a member of a number of professional and honorary societies and holds office in several.
