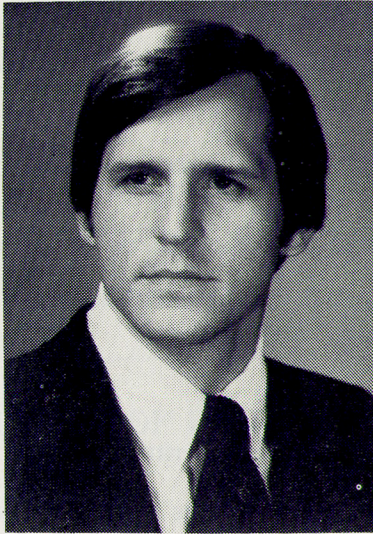

The youngest state budget director in the nation will address the 1979 summer graduates at Northeast Missouri State University this evening.

William D. Dye, 27-year-old director of the Missouri Division of Budget and Planning, Office of Administration, will deliver the 1979 Summer Commencement Address.

Dye's duties as budget director include directing a professional staff in preparing the \$4 billion state budget which the governor presents to the legislature; advising the governor on spending and tax policy; guiding Missouri's federal relations efforts; and directing the state government's planning efforts.

The director began his career with the Missouri Division of Budget and Planning in 1974 as an analyst. He was appointed manager of the Human Services Section of the division in 1977. The following year Dye became the assistant director for federal relations, a position he held five months before being appointed budget director.

Dye graduated magna cum laude from the University of Missouri-Columbia with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and a Master of Science in Public Administration. Among his academic honors, he was a "University Scholar" and a member of Phi Beta Kappa honorary.
