Comrade *Andrew D. Madden* is *68* years of age was born in *Dauphin Co.*
State of *Pennsylvania* and is by occupation a *Drummer Boy*, entered the service on the
19th day of *January* 1862 as a *Private* Co. *B* 11th Regt. *Mo. S. M. Cav.*
and was finally discharged on the *30th* day of *October* 1862 as *Private* Co. *B*
Eleventh Regt. *Mo. S. M. Cav.* by reason of *Disease of Lungs*,
having served *9* months. Joined this Post by *Transfer* March 15 1894.
